



## Asbestos removal works commencing 7 August 2023

From Monday 7 August works are commencing to remove asbestos identified in the existing on-grade car park on Hospital Road as part of the construction of the new multi-storey carpark at Concord Hospital.

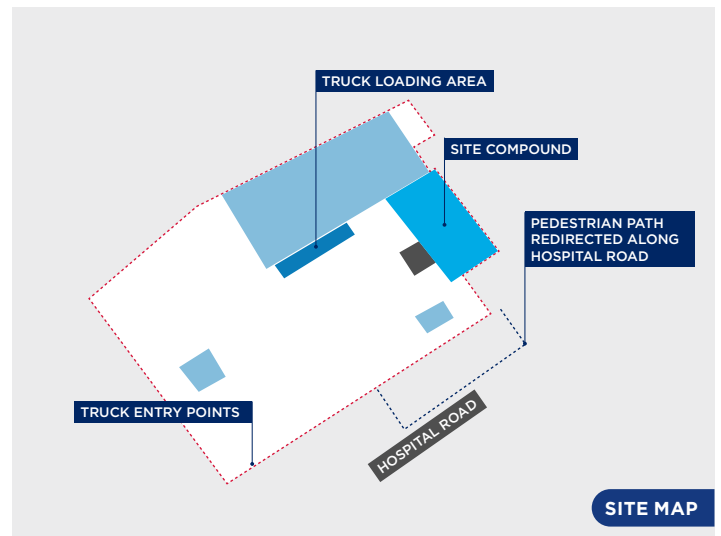
For the safety of staff, patients and visitors, an exclusion zone will be in place around the removal works and the affected area within the compound will be covered with heavy duty plastic sheeting.

The works are expected to take three weeks to complete and will be between the hours of 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

To ensure the safe navigation around the works and to protect pedestrians, there will be a temporary closure of the footpath and walking track near the site.

The below additional safety measures will be in place for the duration of works:

- Qualified asbestos removal workers suited in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will carry out the planned works
- Air monitoring will take place and water trucks will be used to suppress any dust throughout the works as a precautionary measure
- Trucks removing the material will be loaded within the site and covered to ensure the safe transport of contaminated materials
- Once works are complete an independent assessor will review the site to provide clearance certificates
- There will be minimal traffic disruption with traffic control in place to help people navigate the space.
